RESOLUTION NO. 6858

A RESOLUTION certifying the existence of an emergency and authorizing staff to waive the contract bidding process for construction of emergency public works to address damage to traffic signal conduit and cables and access to traffic signal control equipment in the vicinity of NE 4<sup>th</sup> Street and 108<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE.

WHEREAS, a public safety hazard exists consisting of damaged traffic signal cable and conduit and access to the traffic signal control equipment at NE 4<sup>th</sup> Street and 108<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE; and

WHEREAS, if the said equipment is not repaired there is a likelihood that the traffic signal will be left inoperable if failure were to occur, resulting in the disruption of traffic and the potential for traffic accidents; and

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2003, the City Manager declared a state of emergency pursuant to BCC 4.28.140, RCW 35.22.620 and RCW 39.04.280; and

WHEREAS, said emergency requires immediate execution of certain public works in order to protect property within the City; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to BCC 4.28.140, RCW 35.22.620 and RCW 39.04.280, the City Council hereby certifies the existence of an emergency situation arising from damage to traffic signal conduit and cables and access to traffic signal control equipment described in the Declaration of Emergency issued by the City Manager on May 15, 2003, which situation requires emergency public works without formal bid.
