## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

### RESOLUTION NO. 6863

A RESOLUTION authorizing the City Council to adopt the Master Plan Alternative 4, as well as adopting "Meadow Wood Park" as the official park name for the new park located at 13817 SE 60th Place, Bellevue.

WHEREAS, one of the goals of the Parks Open Space and Recreation Element of the Comprehensive Plan is to develop, operate and maintain parkland and cultural and recreation facilities in a manner that is responsive to the site and the needs of the community;

WHEREAS, Policy PA-1 of the Comprehensive Plan is to establish a coordinated and connected system of open space and greenways throughout the City that provide multiple benefits including preserving natural systems, protecting wildlife habitat and corridors as well as provide land for recreation;

WHEREAS, Policy PA-4 of the Comprehensive Plan is to equitably distribute neighborhood park and recreation opportunities by type throughout the City;

WHEREAS, Policy PA-18 of the Comprehensive Plan is to develop a variety of active and passive facilities in a coordinated system of neighborhood and community parks;

WHEREAS, Policy S-SB-1 of the Comprehensive Plan is to recognize existing land use patterns and densities while providing for the maintenance of services, public facilities and utilities appropriate to serve the area;

WHEREAS, the development of neighborhood facilities was identified as one of the community's top priority for park facilities;

WHEREAS, the Master Plan Alternative 4 meets both the priorities set forth in the Bellevue Parks and Open Space System Plan and the Comprehensive Plan Policies PA-1, PA-4, PA-18, and S-SB-1; and

WHEREAS, "Meadow Wood Park" meets both the priorities as set forth in the Bellevue Parks and Open Space Systems Plan and the criteria set by Resolution 4803 which established policies and procedures relating to the naming of public parks and parks and recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Master Plan Alternative 4 and the name "Meadow Wood Park" as the official park name was approved by the Parks and Community Services Board on August 13, 2003; now therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES

Clerk's Receiving No. 34062 is hereby adopted.


Section 2. "Meadow Wood Park" is hereby adopted as the official park name.


# Vicinity Map
