RESOLUTION NO. 6932

A RESOLUTION A Resolution authorizing the City Manager or his designee to submit a grant application to the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, as provided for in Chapter 79A.25 RCW, requesting up to \$75,000.00 for funding assistance in the development of the Highland Park Outdoor Skate Park, a Youth Athletic Facilities Program project.

WHEREAS, the City desires to undertake development of the Highland Park Outdoor Skate Park which is an eligible project of the Youth Athletic Facilities Program (YAF) project;

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue (City) desires financial assistance in the development of the Park;

WHEREAS, funding assistance is available for a YAF project from the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation (IAC) as provided in Chapter 79A.25 RCW;

WHEREAS, under the provisions of YAF, state funding assistance is requested to aid in financing the cost of facility development; and

WHEREAS, the City considers it in the best public interest to complete the development project described in the application; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager (or his designee) is authorized to make formal application to IAC for funding assistance for up to \$75,000.00;
2. If awarded a grant, any fund assistance received will be used for implementation of the Highland Park Outdoor Skate Park project;
3. The City hereby certifies that, if awarded, it has sufficient funding available in the City of Bellevue's Capital Investment Fund and will commit this funding towards its share of project funding;
4. The City acknowledges that any facility developed with IAC financial aid must be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use for a minimum of 20 years from final reimbursement unless otherwise provided and agreed to by the City and IAC;
5. This resolution will become part of a formal application to IAC; and
6. The City has provided appropriate opportunity for public comment on this application.
