RESOLUTION NO. 7078

A RESOLUTION authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute an Interlocal Agreement between the United States Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and the Bellevue Police Department, for the use of one Police Department officer on the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Task Force, and the DEA's reimbursement of the City's overtime payments incurred as a result of the officer's participation on the Task Force.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement between the United States Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and the Bellevue Police Department, providing for the use of one Police Department officer on the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Task Force for two years, and, subject to availability of funds, the DEA's reimbursement of the City's overtime payments incurred as a result of the officer's participation on the Task Force up to a maximum of \$14,115.75 per year (\$28,231.50 for two years), a copy of which contract has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 36470.
