RESOLUTION NO. 7098

A RESOLUTION authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute, on behalf of the City, as approved by the City Attorney's Office, a Memorandum of Understanding between the City and SEAFAIR for the purpose of providing services and support for a half marathon, a 5k walk/run and a full marathon from 2005 through 2007, which includes but is not limited to, a marketing package, a services and support plan, and a cost sharing plan.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue is interested in supporting SEAFAIR events which includes a half marathon, 5k walk/run and a full marathon from 2005 through 2007; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue believes these events will enhance the City's economic development goals, will provide opportunities for direct financial benefits to local businesses and non profit organizations and will provide access to high quality community events for Bellevue residents to enjoy; and

WHEREAS, SEAFAIR and the City of Bellevue have agreed to develop strategies and alternatives to further mutual interests in proportion to the growth and increased success of the events including a cost sharing plan, a marketing package and a service and support plan; and

WHEREAS, SEAFAIR and the City of Bellevue have agreed to work cooperatively to plan the event routes in order to accommodate local concerns including assisting in SEAFAIR's community outreach programs related to event planning; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, as approved by the City Attorney's Office, a Memorandum of Understanding in substantially the same form, between the City and SEAFAIR for the purpose of providing services and support for a half marathon, a 5k walk/run and a full marathon from 2005 through 2007, which includes but is not limited to, a marketing package, a services and support plan, and a cost sharing plan, a copy of which Memorandum of Understanding has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 37323.
