RESOLUTION NO. 7587

A RESOLUTION authorizing the City Manager or his designee (1) to execute any and all documents, including amendments, with Locution Systems, Inc., for the purchase, implementation, and maintenance of a new voice announcement and alerting system that will be utilized by King County Fire Zone 1 agencies, in an amount not to exceed \$530,369.47, plus any applicable taxes; (2) to execute a Fourth Amendment to the Emergency Fire and Medical Communication Services Agreement to provide for the ongoing maintenance and replacement of the hardware, software, and associated equipment supplied as integral parts of the new station alerting system; and correct the erroneous numbering of the First Amendment to the Emergency Fire and Medical Communication Services Agreement given Clerk's Receiving Number 40600 so that now it is appropriately titled the Third Amendment to The Emergency Fire and Medical Communication Services Agreement.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, including amendments, with Locution Systems, Inc., for the purchase, implementation and maintenance of a new voice announcement and alerting system that will be utilized by King County Fire Zone 1 agencies in an amount not to exceed \$530,369.47, plus any applicable taxes, a copy of which agreements have been given Clerk's Receiving No. 41402.

Section 2. The City Manager or his her designee is authorized to execute the Fourth Amendment to the Emergency Fire and Medical Communication Services Agreement to provide for the ongoing maintenance and replacement of the hardware, software and associated equipment supplied as integral parts of the new station alerting system; and, to correct the erroneous numbering of the First Amendment to the Emergency Fire and Medical Communication Services Agreement given Clerk's Receiving Number 40600 so that now it is appropriately titled the Third Amendment to The Emergency Fire and Medical Communication Services Agreement, a copy of which Fourth Amendment has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 43705.


