

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 7623

A RESOLUTION authorizing the City Manager or his designee to adopt and approve a hazard mitigation annex, upon approval by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), to be incorporated into the King County Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue is vulnerable to the human and economic costs of natural, technological, and societal disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Bellevue City Council recognizes the importance of reducing or eliminating those vulnerabilities for the health, safety, and welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has been an active participant in the Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan of the King County Task Force, which has established a comprehensive coordinated planning process to eliminate or decrease these vulnerabilities of the City of Bellevue to the impacts of future disasters; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has identified potential hazards in the Bellevue community, assessed potential impacts, and developed strategies to help mitigate the impacts before, during, and after a disaster through a Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, Bellevue's Hazard Mitigation Plan serves as an annex to the King County Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan because it deals with issues specific to Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, Bellevue's Hazard Mitigation Plan Annex will be submitted to FEMA and to King County for approval; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is required to adopt a resolution stating its intent to formally adopt a Hazard Mitigation Plan annex to King County's Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan for FEMA approval; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The Bellevue City Council states its intent to accept and approve of Bellevue's Hazard Mitigation Plan annex to the King County Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan upon FEMA approval of such Bellevue Annex; and

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents needed to approve and adopt the Bellevue's Hazard Mitigation Plan annex to the King County Regional Hazard Mitigation

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute any and all documents needed to secure grant funding related to the Bellevue Hazard Mitigation Plan annex to the King County Regional Hazard Mitigation, a copy of which annex has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 43409.


