RESOLUTION NO. 7766

A RESOLUTION initiating vacation of a portion of NE 26th Street between 100th Avenue NE and 102nd Avenue NE and setting a time and place for a hearing to consider such a vacation.

WHEREAS, the City Council received a petition to initiate the vacation of a certain City right-of-way set forth in Section 1 herein and desires to set a time and place for a hearing before the City Council to consider such vacation; now , therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby initiates the vacation, pursuant to section 14.35.030 of the Bellevue City Code, of the following City right-of-way:

A portion of NE 26th Street between 100th Avenue NE & 102nd Avenue NE, more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

Section 2. A public hearing shall be held upon the proposal to vacate the City right-of-way set forth in Section 1 on September 2, 2008 at the hour of 6:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard by the City Council, in the Council Chambers at the Bellevue City Hall, 450 110th Avenue NE, Bellevue, Washington.

Section 3. Notice of such hearing shall be provided and posted in the manner required by Sections 14.35.050 of the Bellevue City Code inviting interested persons to appear and be heard for or against the proposed vacation.

Section 4. This matter is referred to the City Manager or his designee for investigation and report, as necessary, at said public hearing.


