RESOLUTION NO. 8517

A RESOLUTION authorizing execution of 1) amendment #3 to the Interlocal Agreement between the Washington State Department of Transportation and the City of Bellevue for final design of pedestrian and bicycle improvements along Northup Way (GCA 6668, SR 520 Interim Regional Pedestrian and Bicycle Path); and 2) amendment #2 to the consultant agreement with Jacobs Engineering Group Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$656,631 (plus any applicable taxes), to advance the design from 60% to final design for the Northup Way Corridor Improvements, 108th Avenue NE to NE 24th Street (CIP Plan No. PW-R-146).

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute 1) amendment #3 to the Interlocal Agreement between the State of Washington Department of Transportation and the City of Bellevue for final design of pedestrian and bicycle improvements along Northup Way (GCA 6668, SR 520 Interim Regional Pedestrian and Bicycle Path); and 2) amendment #2 to the consultant agreement with Jacobs Engineering Group Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$656,631 (plus any applicable taxes), to advance the design from 60% to final design for the Northup Way Corridor Improvements, 108th Avenue NE to NE 24th Street (CIP Plan No PW-R-146), a copy of which amendment to the Interlocal Agreement and supplement to the consultant agreement has been given Clerk's receiving Nos. 49765 and 49739.
