RESOLUTION NO. 8524

A RESOLUTION amending the adopted City of Bellevue State Legislative Agenda for the 2013 legislative session.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the city government is to provide high quality service to its citizens in the most efficient and effective manner possible; and

WHEREAS, cities in Washington are subject to state legislative action; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue believes that local government can be the most effective level of government if given the opportunity and should be given the authority to make decisions which are primarily local in nature; and

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2012, the Bellevue City Council passed Resolution No. 8488 adopting the City's State Legislative Agenda for 2013 and subsequently transmitted the Agenda to the State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2013, the Bellevue City Council directed that the City's State Legislative Agenda be amended to include a revised policy statement regarding the SR 520 Bridge Replacement Project to achieve consistency with the City's Federal Legislative Agenda; and

WHEREAS, the Bellevue City Council wishes to communicate its additional legislative priorities to members of the Washington State Legislature; now, therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Favorable consideration by the Washington State Legislature of the issues identified in the Amended State Legislative Agenda for 2013, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 49726, will enable the City of Bellevue to more effectively serve its residents. Therefore, the Amended State Legislative Agenda for 2013 is hereby adopted.

Section 2. The Amended State Legislative Agenda for 2013 shall be conveyed to the appropriate members of the Washington State Legislature and shall form the basis for City of Bellevue communications with state legislators during the 2013 legislative session. The State Legislative Statement of Policy shall be utilized by City Council and staff in determining how to respond to other opportunities and issues which arise in the 2013 Legislative Session.
