

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 8852

A RESOLUTION authorizing the execution of all documents transferring ownership of the South Vasa Sewer Trunk Line from the City to King County.

WHEREAS, the South Vasa Sewer Trunk Line was designed and constructed from 1991 to 1993 under the City's Capital Investment Program (CIP) as project S-31; and

WHEREAS, as part of the project, easements were obtained over six privately owned parcels from West Lake Sammamish Parkway SE to Lake Sammamish; and

WHEREAS, the remainder of the sewer line lies within either City of Bellevue right-of-way, or within Washington State Department of Transportation controlled right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the King County Regional Wastewater Services Plan Policy (RWSP Conveyance Policy CP-5) stipulates in part that "King County shall apply uniform criteria throughout its service area for the financing, development, ownership, operation, maintenance, repair and replacement of all conveyance facilities; and

WHEREAS; the criteria shall include County ownership and operation of permanent conveyance facilities that serve natural drainage area greater than one thousand acres"; and

WHEREAS, in 2012 the Utilities Department contacted King County proposing to transfer the Vasa Sewer Trunk Line facilities and easements to King County; and

WHEREAS, King County evaluated the proposed transfer in accordance with criteria and agreed to accept, maintain service to existing customers, assume maintenance and repair of the system from the date of transfer forward, and fund the future replacement once the assets reach their service life; and

WHEREAS, completing this sewer line transfer results in an immediate payment of \$1,151,352 to the Utilities Department, which covers the cost of the original construction for the sanitary sewer system and related easements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems that it is in the City's best public interest to transfer the South Vasa Sewer Trunk line from the Bellevue Utility Department to King County and that the mutual consideration of said transfer benefit both the Utility Department and King County; now, therefore,


