RESOLUTION NO. 8888

A RESOLUTION authorizing the execution of all documents necessary to enter into an agreement for the Congregations for the Homeless/King County Housing Authority Men's Winter Shelter; for the Regional Equitable Development Initiative (REDI) fund; and for the Parkview XI home for low income persons with developmental disabilities as recommended by the ARCH (A Regional Coalition for Housing) Executive Board, utilizing funds from the City's Housing Fund, in an amount not to exceed \$689,400.

WHEREAS, A Regional Coalition for Housing (ARCH) was created by interlocal agreement to help coordinate the efforts of Eastside cities to provide affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, the ARCH Executive Board has recommended that the City participate in the funding of certain affordable housing projects and programs hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the ARCH Executive Board has developed a number of recommended conditions to ensure that the City's affordable housing funds are used for their intended purpose and that projects maintain their affordability over time; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to use \$689,400 from City funds as designated below to finance the projects recommended by the ARCH Executive Board; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents and take all necessary actions to enter into Agreements on behalf of the City to fund the Congregations for the Homeless/King County Housing Authority Men's Winter Shelter in an amount not to exceed \$383,500; for the Regional Equitable Development Initiative (REDI) fund in an amount not to exceed \$250,000; and for the Parkview XI home for low income persons with developmental disabilities in an amount not to exceed \$55,900.

Section 2. The Agreements entered into pursuant to Section 1 of this resolution shall be funded from the City's Housing fund in an amount not to exceed that set forth in Section 1. Such Agreements shall include terms and conditions to ensure that the City's funds are used for their intended purpose and that the project maintains its affordability over time. In determining what conditions should be


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included in the Agreements, the City Manager or his designee shall be guided by the recommendations set forth in the ARCH Executive Board's memorandum of December 12, 2014, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 53360.
