
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of the public hearing on the East Link light rail routing options in Bellevue. This topic will be discussed before the Bellevue City Council in the Bellevue City Council Chambers, 450 110th Avenue NE, at 8:00 p.m. on Monday, February 2, 2009.

The public hearing is an opportunity for residents and other stakeholders to provide input to the Bellevue City Council on which East Link routing option the Council should recommend as the preferred routing in Bellevue. Sound Transit has studied numerous routing options and at-grade, elevated, or tunnel profiles for light rail to travel from I-90, into downtown Bellevue, through the Bel-Red area, and on to Overlake and downtown Redmond. In late February, the Council will make a recommendation for a Bellevue-preferred routing to the Sound Transit Board, which makes the final routing decision. Interested persons are encouraged to attend the public hearing and to provide written and/or oral testimony.
