Join Bellevue Parks & Community Services and the American Volkssport Association for Bellevue's Little Lake-to-Lake Earth Day 5K Walk. This easy walk follows the Lake Hills Greenbelt Trail connecting Larsen and Phantom Lakes. The trail winds through a rich variety of natural, historic, and agricultural areas which date back over 100 years. Earth Education Stations set up in the park are designed to inspire you and your family to greater awareness and stewardship of the earth. Highlights include: King County Master Gardener site, Larsen and Phantom Lakes, Larsen Lake Pioneer Cabin, and more! This family-friendly walk is wheelchair and stroller-friendly.

- Distance:** 5K (2.3 miles approximately 2 hours to complete)
Cost: Free
Registration: Day of the event registration at the start point between 2 and 5pm
Start: Lake Hills Greenbelt Community Gardens
Parking: Lake Hills Greenbelt Community Gardens, 156th Ave and SE 16th St or Phantom Lake, 156th Ave & 20th Pl
Finish: By 7pm

Other: Adults are responsible for the safety and supervision of children at all times. Follow designated event trail markers and abide by street crossing rules.

2009 Bellevue Park Walks

The Little Lake-to-Lake Walk is the first of a 4-part series of free walking events highlighting Bellevue's beautiful Parks & Open Space System. Walks vary in difficulty and length. Not all walks may be suitable for small children and strollers. A 2009 Walking Passport will be available at each walk. Stamped Passport is required for prize entry: Complete all 4 walks and enter to win a prize!


