


**KELSEY CREEK FARM FAIR

Free Shuttle and Parking

- Free parking and a free shuttle bus to and from the event located at the Bannerwood Sports Park, 1630 – 132nd Ave. SE.
- Driving directions to Bannerwood: From I-405, take SE 8th Street exit east. Turn right on Lake Hills Connector. At "Y" intersection, keep right turning onto Richards Road. Turn left at sign.
- Shuttle bus leaves approximately every 15 minutes.
- Shuttle starts at 11 am at Bannerwood, last shuttle from Kelsey is at 3:15 pm.
- Disabled & Event Permit parking are in the main parking lot of the park. Valid disable parking permit or Kelsey Event Permit is required to park on site.
