


Sheep Shearing

Driving Directions

Wilburton Park & Ride, 720 114th Ave SE, Bellevue *Shuttle Service available*

From 405:

- Take Exit 12 (SE 8th Street).
- Turn WEST at SE 8th Street.
- Turn right on 114th Ave. SE.
- Park & Ride on the right.

Bannerwood Sports Park, 1630 132nd Ave SE, Bellevue *Shuttle Service Available*

From 405:

- Take Exit 12 (SE 8th Street).
- Turn EAST at SE 8th Street.
- Turn right on Lake Hills Connector.
- At the "Y" intersection, keep right turning onto Richards Road.
- Turn left at Bannerwood Sports Park.

Kelsey Creek Farm Park, 410 130th Pl SE, Bellevue

From 405:

- Take Exit 12 (SE 8th Street).
- Turn EAST at light (SE 8th Street) towards train trestle; go through next light; get into middle lane and follow road through light at Lake Hills Connector.
- Turn LEFT at stop sign (128th AV SE).
- Turn RIGHT at SE 4th PL.; Kelsey Creek Farm Park is straight ahead.

No parking on site day of event. Parking available on local streets and International School.
