

Lake-to-Lake Trail Walk – 15 K

Connecting Parks, People and Nature

Saturday, Sept 13 – Bellevue, Washington

Join the Northwest Striders and the Bellevue Parks Department to hike one of the nation's most spectacular urban greenway trails. Like pearls on a necklace, Bellevue's Lake to Lake Trail connects pristine open space parks, farms, forests, wetlands, formal botanical gardens, and neighborhoods between Lake Sammamish and Lake Washington.

Cost: Free for the general public and \$3.00 per person for Volkssport members.

Registration: All participants must register the morning of the event, between 8 a.m. and 10 a.m., at the Mercer Slough Blueberry Farm, 2380 Bellevue Way SE – pre-event registration is not available.

Parking: Various sites at the Mercer Slough Nature Park, along Bellevue Way SE. Take I-90: exit # 9 (Bellevue Way). Go north on Bellevue Way. Parking will be on your right. Look for Volkssport sign and arrows.

Shuttle Bus: Participants will be shuttled from the Mercer Slough Blueberry Farm to the start of the Lake to Lake Trail at Weowna Park. Shuttle will run between the hours of 8am and 10am.

Start: 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. at Weowna Park, West Lake Sammamish Pkwy. Shuttle bus parking only!

Finish: Mercer Slough Blueberry Farm. By 4 p.m.
