

15th Annual Lake-to-Lake Walk

Saturday, Sept 18 — Bellevue, Washington

Join the Northwest Striders and the Bellevue Parks & Community Services Department to hike one of the nation's most spectacular urban greenway trails. Like pearls on a necklace, Bellevue's Lake-to-Lake Trail connects pristine open space parks, farms, forests, wetlands, formal botanical gardens, and neighborhoods between Lake Sammamish and Lake Washington. Special highlights include the King County Master Gardener Harvest Festival and the Fraser Pioneer Cabin, open to all walkers. 15K Lake-to-Lake Trail route is not suitable for stroller or small children. 6K route is available in the Mercer Slough Nature Park. - Cost:** Free for the general public and \$3 per person for Volkssport members
- Registration:** 15K participants must register the morning of the event, between 8–10 am, at the Mercer Slough Blueberry Farm, 2380 Bellevue Way SE – pre-event registration is not available. 6K registration open until 12noon.
- Shuttle Bus:** Participants of the 15K walk will be shuttled from the Mercer Slough Blueberry Farm to the start of the Lake-to-Lake Trail at Weowna Park. Shuttle will run between 8–10 am
- Finish:** Mercer Slough Blueberry Farm, by 3 pm
- Parking:** South Bellevue Park & Ride, 2700 Bellevue Way. From the Park & Ride walk north on Bellevue Way to the Mercer Slough Blueberry Farm.
