Station Design vs. Station Area Planning

Sound Transit is responsible for station design:

- Physical layout, appearance and function of the light rail station

City of Bellevue is responsible for station area planning:

- Everything that happens outside of the station and related structures

Why Station Area Planning?

Two main reasons for planning around stations:

- 1) To create a more compatible fit with the neighborhood; and
- 2) To take advantage of the station location by making it easier, and safer, to get to.

3. Identify stakeholders who would like to stay involved in this process


Public Participation Process

without planter




5 ft. sidewalk

4 ft. planter






