

CITY COUNCIL AGENDA MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT

Resolution No. 8393 authorizing and directing the City Manager to execute the Interlocal Agreement between the King County Flood Control District, King County, and the City of Bellevue to Transfer Assets and Responsibilities of the former South West Lake Sammamish Flood Control Zone District to Bellevue.

FISCAL IMPACT

This Interlocal Agreement will transfer approximately \$140,000 of remaining funds from the former South West Lake Sammamish Flood Control Zone District (District) to the City of Bellevue. The City is receiving these funds because the District was dissolved and is already largely served by the City. Consistent with the City's Utilities' policies for one time revenue the funds will be put into the Utilities Renewal and Replacement Fund for Stormwater. Minimal impact to operations and maintenance is expected as Bellevue Utilities already maintains the majority of the system previously owned by the District, and located in Bellevue.

POLICY CONSIDERATION

The former South West Lake Sammamish Flood Control Zone District (and other similar districts) was dissolved when the countywide King County Flood Control Zone District was established in 2007 by King County. Formal Council action is needed to transfer facilities and remaining financial assets in the amount of \$140,000 to Bellevue.

BACKGROUND

In June 1964, the King County Board of Commissioners, now the King County Council, adopted Resolution No. 28067 forming the South West Lake Sammamish Flood Control Zone District (District) in an area of unincorporated King County. Most of the area is now part of the City of Bellevue, with a small area remaining in unincorporated King County. The attached map shows the boundaries of the former District. Fees were collected by the District to fund the construction and maintenance of a number of stormwater control facilities, and a portion of these funds remains unspent. The original purposes for which the District was established are now being satisfied by the stormwater programs in Bellevue and the County, and the former District facilities located in Bellevue are being maintained by Bellevue Utilities.

On April 25, 2007, the King County Council enacted Ordinance 15728 authorizing the formation of the countywide King County Flood Control Zone District (KCFCD) and dissolving all previously existing flood control districts in King County, including the South West Lake Sammamish District. All of the responsibilities and assets of the District were transferred to the KCFCD.

An Interlocal Agreement between the KCFCD, King County and Bellevue will transfer to Bellevue any stormwater related property interests and responsibility for drainage facilities within Bellevue, transfer to the County any property interests and facilities outside of Bellevue, and transfer the remaining financial assets of the District to Bellevue.

The Interlocal Agreement was approved on December 12, 2011, by the KCFCD and January 17, 2012, by the King County Council. This matter was discussed with City Council at the April 23, 2012 Regional Issues discussion.

EFFECTIVE DATE

If approved, this Resolution becomes effective immediately upon Council adoption.

OPTIONS

1. Adopt Resolution No. 8393 authorizing and directing the City Manager to execute the Interlocal Agreement between the King County Flood Control District, King County, and the City of Bellevue to Transfer Assets and Responsibilities of the former South West Lake Sammamish Flood Control Zone District to Bellevue.
2. Do not adopt Resolution No. 8393.


