

CITY COUNCIL AGENDA MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT

Resolution No. 7939 authorizing execution of a four-year General Services Contract with Stripe Rite Inc. in the amount of \$308,739.92 to provide annual city-wide traffic striping maintenance.

FISCAL IMPACT

This agreement commits the City to a four-year General Services Contract with Stripe Rite Inc. for annual city-wide traffic striping maintenance in the amount of \$77,184.98 per year, with a full potential value of \$308,739.92, including all applicable taxes. The 2009-2010 Transportation General Fund Operating Budget includes sufficient funds for these services.

POLICY CONSIDERATION

The City contracts for services when it is cost effective, the work requires specialized equipment or expertise, or there are factors that render it impractical for City staff to perform the work. The proposed Contract is consistent with that practice and with the City's contracting and purchasing policies.

BACKGROUND

Traffic striping requires regular painting to ensure that lane markings and traffic channelization provide clear and highly visible delineation to vehicle traffic. Annual painting of traffic striping is needed to meet City and Federal standards, to reduce the probability of damages and claims, and to meet the City's customer service goals.

RFP RESULTS

The Engineer's Estimate for this project was \$321,033.72. Three contractors submitted quotes for the Citywide Striping Maintenance project as follows:

Stripe Rite Inc.	\$308,739.92
Apply A Line Inc.	\$313,605.24
ClearWin Technologies	\$3,484,459.04

A review of each proposal was conducted and one proposal was found to contain excessively high unit prices. The high unit prices and proposal amount submitted by Clear Win Technologies was confirmed by direct contact as the correct figures submitted for consideration by their company representative. The low quote for this contract by Stripe Rite Inc. is 3.9 % below the Engineer's Estimate. The quote has been evaluated by staff and is considered to be balanced, fair and competitive. The City opted to take advantage of the favorable bidding climate and advertize this project as a four year contract. The successful contractor is willing to perform the work for four years without raising their quoted unit prices.

EFFECTIVE DATE

If adopted, this Resolution will become effective immediately.
