SUBJECT: Vacant EBCC position

At the January 7 meeting, Position No. 1 was declared vacant and you gave direction to recruit for the vacancy. The vacant position was advertised from January 9 through January 22. Four residents submitted applications and their paperwork is included in the packet for your review.

As you know, candidates must reside within the EBCC jurisdictional boundaries. I have vetted each of the four candidates with the King County Elections office. All are registered to vote at an address within the EBCC jurisdiction, which therefore makes any of the candidates eligible for appointment.

I have included an Executive Session on the agenda this evening. If you so choose, you may recess to Executive Session to discuss only the qualifications of the four candidates. You need to return to the open meeting and move to appoint an individual, which then must receive a majority vote in favor. Once the new EBCC member is selected, the individual can be sworn-in at that time or, you may continue the swearing-in to your March agenda.
