SUBJECT: Election of Officers

On Tuesday February 4, 2014 the Community Council will proceed with election of officers. As stated in Section 5 of Resolution 517, the officers will consist of a Chair, Vice Chair and Alternate Vice Chair. The current Chair will preside over the election.

As a reminder, the candidates for each position must receive at least three votes to be elected. The council currently has a vacant seat. If a majority cannot be reached for any of the officer positions, the matter can be continued to the March agenda. After the swearing-in of the newly appointed councilmember in March, the council can then revisit the election of officers.

Resolution 537 has been provided for your approval. If officers are elected at the February 4 meeting, the Resolution will be signed by the newly-elected Chair.
