



Bellevue Fire Department OPEN HOUSE “Ride to School in a Fire Engine” Drawing information, rules, & regulations

Eligibility

Children ages 7 through 15 who live in and attend school in the City of Bellevue, Newcastle, Medina, Beaux Arts, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, or Yarrow Point.

- 1 One entry per child.
- 2 Each child must complete his/her own entry.

Escape Plan Requirements

Each Home Fire Escape Plan must contain:

- 1 A map of the child's home showing all windows and doors.
- 2 Two ways out of each room in the house.
- 3 All smoke detectors on the map.
- 4 A family meeting place outside the home.

Entry Requirements

Entries must be submitted at the Bellevue Fire Department Open House on October 6, 2012 between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

- 1 Entries will be reviewed by a firefighter.
- 2 Completed escape plans will be returned, and the child will be entered in the drawing.
- 3 Entry into the drawing will require a name, and a phone number or email address
