- **There are gaps in the buffer system that need to be plugged to protect the remaining intact vegetation within shoreline jurisdiction when possible, and specifying compensation when not.** 83.1
- **Some incentives allow greater impacts by reducing setbacks, but don't actually improve shoreline conditions as compensation. These need to be eliminated.** 83.2
- **Some state requirements to limit uses not needing to be near the water need to be included, including for institutional-type uses.** 83.3
- **Some intense uses are allowed in Conservancy designated areas which are incompatible with shoreline functions, and should not be allowed.** 83.4




