Scoping of Environmental Issues

This project is informed in part by environmental analyses, using a process referred to as "SEPA/GMA Integration" by the State Environmental Policy Act. To make sure environmental considerations are an integral part of the development and evaluation of alternatives, the CPU will be identifying, or "scoping" environmental issues throughout the planning process. The January 29, 2013, event will provide additional opportunity to identify environmental issues. A formal SEPA determination will occur at a later stage in the planning process.
