- Decide when the design is ready for public comment
- Review community comments about the art and, combining their knowledge of the project, project requirements and goals, and the community's response, develop a recommendation for the Arts Commission to do one of the following.
 - Move forward and build the proposed art
 - Make specific changes in the design and then move forward to build the art
 - Do not build the art
