Kelsey Creek Horsemanship Mini Camps

Kelsey Creek Farm Park is the place for you and your child to learn about equine. Parents/guardians are required to stay for the first day of class while your child's needs are assessed and may be required to stay, at the instructor's discretion, for the remainder of class sessions.

Prior to registering your child, keep in mind a few qualifications are needed for success in any riding class; motivation, strength, and sufficient balance to manage their own body and control a horse, are the most important factors. Children also need to be able to listen for a minimum of 30 minutes. Dress for the weather, we teach rain or shine. Boots with 1/2" heel required. Boot rental available for \$5/day/\$15 for session. Riding helmets provided. Safety is emphasized in all classes. Min 6/Max 8
