## City child care resources offered during school strike

During the Bellevue School District teacher's strike, the City of Bellevue will provide childcare support.

Starting Sept. 2, the city will support the Boys and Girls Clubs of Bellevue's expanded childcare day camp on Sept. 2 at South Bellevue Community Center, 14509 SE Newport Way. For registration information, call 425-452-4240.

The city is also prepared to open day camps for children at two other community centers on Thursday, Sept. 4, if the strike continues. Registration will be required and information will be available on the city's website, or onsite at any city community center or Bellevue City Hall.

- The Boys and Girls Clubs of Bellevue's expanded day camp will be open at South Bellevue Community Center, 14509 SE Newport Way
- **Starts Tuesday, Sept. 2**
- **Hours: 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.**
- Open to elementary-age children
- Cost will be \$40 per day (\$20 if already enrolled in Project Learn Afterschool program).
- Space is limited and camps will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Campers will need to bring their own lunch, but snacks will be provided. For registration information, call 425-452-4240.

- **Starts Sept. 4, Registration opens Wed., Sept. 3**
- **Hours: 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.**
- Cost will be \$40 per day; scholarships will be available.
- Campers will need to bring their own lunch, but snacks will be provided.
- Space is limited and camps will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
