Thursday, September 1: "The Blind Side"

This Academy Award-winning movie tells the true story of Michael Oher, a homeless teen, who has drifted in and out of the school and the child protective services system for years. Then Leigh Anne Tuohy (Sandra Bullock) and her husband, Sean (Tim McGraw), take him in. The Tuohys become Michael's legal guardians, transforming both his life and theirs. Michael's tremendous size and protective instincts make him a formidable force on the gridiron -with help from his new family and devoted tutor, he realizes his potential as a student and football player.

Thursday, September 8: "Oh Brother, Where Art Thou?"

Starring George Clooney and Holly Hunter. Loosely based on Homer's 'Odyssey' the movie tells of the picaresque adventures of Everett Ulysses McGill and his companions Delmar and Pete in 1930's Mississippi. The three are sprung from a prison chain gang and are trying to recover the buried loot of a bank heist. They are confronted by a series of strange characters, among them a bank robber, a campaigning Governor, his opponent, and a blind prophet who warns the trio that "the treasure you seek shall not be the treasure you find."

Thursday, September 16: "A River Runs Through It"

Academy Award-winning film based on Norman MacLean's autobiography, directed by Robert Redford and starring Brad Pitt. Tells the story of two brothers, Norman and Paul and chronicles their intertwining and often conflicting lives as they grow up in the shadow of their father, a Presbyterian minister. Norman goes to the east coast for college and returns home after six years, mature and channeling his rebellion through teaching. His reckless brother Paul, a rebellious journalist, turns to gambling and liquor.

Thursday, September 23: "Riverdance"

The beautiful and energetic dancing of Michael Flatley and the eighty-member Riverdance Irish dance troupe perform their twirling jigs to wonderful Irish music. The troupe performs their famed stage show featuring a modern, percussive approach to traditional Celtic dance. Special guests include Anuna, flamenco specialist Maria Pages and Moscow's Moiseyev Dance Company.

Thursday, September 30: "Life As We Know It"

Caterer Holly Berenson and network sports director Eric Messer discover a reciprocal hatred during an ill-fated first date but are forced to put their feelings aside when their mutual friends die and they become the guardians for orphaned Sophie. Now, Holly and Eric must learn to live with each other and juggle their promising careers while taking care of the little girl in this romantic comedy.
