- Poems not to exceed 12 lines.
- Park photos can be from any season.
- One poem and/or photo per person. Poems and photos need not relate to one another.
- Must live, work or play in Bellevue to participate.
- All ages welcome.
- Work must be suitable for the general public.
- Photo waivers required when photo includes images of people. Waivers must be signed by each subject and submitted with entry. Waiver located with submittal form.

Selection panel will include art professionals and representatives of the City of Bellevue.
