

Phantom Lake Walkway

This is a wonderful trail for that escape from the office, lunchtime jog or an after-school walk to give the kids an alternative to afternoon TV. This loop is a 2.6 mile long asphalt path designed to handle high density use. Lots of trees along the path create a relaxing atmosphere. You'll hear songbirds and see squirrels scurrying up the trunks of the trees. On 168th Avenue, the loop connects to Weowna Park trailhead and on to Lake Sammamish. Some of the oldest and biggest trees known to exist in Bellevue grow here. The Phantom Lake Walkway connects with Lake hills Greenbelt at 156th Avenue SE and Se 16th Street.
