




# Wilburton Hill Park Trail

Wilburton Hill Park is the largest upland park in the city, encompassing a wide variety of active and passive recreational opportunities. Completed in 1991, the 105-acre community park showcases a botanical garden, providing demonstration and educational opportunities. Active play enthusiasts can take advantage of the soccer and ballfields, tennis and basketball courts, group picnic facilities, and children's play area. Despite these activities, the park's primary function is to protect and enhance the original natural areas, forests and wildlife habitats. A major link in the Lake-to-Lake Trail system traverses the park.
