SUBJECT: Briefing on the 2009 Comprehensive Plan Amendments (CPA) Annual Work Program established by City Council

The Bellevue City Council at its May 18, 2009, meeting established the 2009 CPA Annual Work Program by initiating two staff-requested amendments. These are the Capital Facilities for 2009-2015 CPA and the Transportation Element Figure TR.2 – Travel Demand Forecasts CPA (the Council did not act on any privately-proposed amendments this year as the two that were submitted withdrew their applications prior to Council action on Threshold Review.)

Capital Facilities for 2009-2015 CPA

This city-initiated CPA proposes to amend the Capital Facilities Element of the Comprehensive Plan, updating references to include the adopted six-year 2009-2015 Capital Investment Program.

Capital Facilities Element map and policy amendments include:

- Change the year reference in the CIP listing on p. 75 from 2007-2013 to 2009-2015;
- Replace Tables CF.3 and CF.4 with their most recent versions.

Transportation Element Figure TR.2 – Travel Demand Forecasts CPA

This city-initiated CPA proposes to amend the Transportation Element to update Figure TR.2 - Travel Demand Forecasts—because the information is out of date, and needs to reflect Mobility Management Area (MMA) boundaries recently modified.

Staff anticipate scheduling public hearings on these amendments to occur in October. Final city action on these amendments will likely occur near the end of the year.
