Why Should I Make the Switch?

Installing a high efficiency showerhead is an easy way to reduce water and energy consumption without sacrificing your comfort. You'll not only reduce your water and energy bills, but you'll be helping to fight climate change.

The average family of four uses 400 gallons of water each day. By using high efficiency showerheads and aerators, families can reduce water usage by 20% or 80 gallons a day. In addition, showerheads will save an average of 190 kWh per year. Customers with gas water heat will save on their gas bill as well.

Are Showerheads Difficult to Install?

Installing an efficient showerhead is as easy as 1-2-3. First, carefully unscrew your old showerhead. You might need a wrench or spanner to loosen it. Second, wrap a small amount of silicone tape around the spout's screw thread. Finally, screw on the new showerhead (snug, but not too tight). Your new showerhead is ready to go!
