liquefaction	Liquefaction susceptibility areas. Shows areas at most risk of liquefaction in the event of an earthquake.
soils	Boundaries of the soil types found in the general Bellevue area.

lakes	Boundaries and names of lakes in the Bellevue area.
streams	Location and names of major streams within Bellevue.

building Building outlines for buildings in, or near, the City of Bellevue.

Planning (plan)

cbddesign Boundaries of the design districts for the Central Business District (CBD) of Bellevue.

commcoun Boundary of the East Bellevue Community Council.

complan2 Boundaries and land use designations for the comprehensive plan areas of Bellevue. These land use designations provide guidance about the intensity of land use that is approved for each area.

GMA Shows the location of the Growth Management Act boundary (also known as the urban growth boundary) in the vicinity of southeastern Bellevue, eastern Newcastle, and western Issaquah.

mftrans Locations of Bellevue's multi-family transition areas. Certain types of development are not allowed in these areas. These areas are meant to serve as buffers between areas that are zoned multi-family, and areas that are zoned for more intensive uses (for example, commercial or industrial uses).

nbrhood Boundaries and names of the neighborhood associations within Bellevue.

nepliasn Boundaries and names of the Neighborhood Enhancement Program/Neighborhood Liaison areas within Bellevue.

sftrans Locations of Bellevue's single-family transition areas. Certain types of development are not allowed in these areas. These areas are meant to serve as buffers between areas that are zoned single-family, and areas that are zoned for more intensive uses (for example, commercial or industrial uses).

subareas Boundaries and names of the planning subareas in, or near, the City of Bellevue.



zoning The boundaries of Bellevue's zoning areas.

Public Land Survey System (plss)

orthoindex Orthophoto (aerial photography) tile index.

grid Locations, and designations for, the cells of the quartersection grid for the Bellevue area.

sectiongrid Locations, and designations for, the cells of the PLSS Sections grid.

Property (prop)

facility Location and name of various city, county, state, federal and private facilities in or near Bellevue.

parcels Boundaries and King County parcel identification (KCPARCEL) numbers. The areas covered include Bellevue, Beaux Arts, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina, Newcastle, Yarrow Point, the southern part of Kirkland and Redmond, the northern part of Renton, and various nearby unincorporated areas of King County.

Recreation (rec)

otherparks Boundaries and names of the parks in Bellevue, Medina, Newcastle, Redmond, Yarrow Point, southern Kirkland, northern Renton, and nearby areas of unincorporated King County that are not owned by the City of Bellevue.

parcsproperty Boundaries and names of the parcels of land in Bellevue and Redmond that are owned by the City of Bellevue, and which are currently, or will potentially be, devoted to either recreation, open space or human services.

parcsite Boundaries and names of City of Bellevue-owned parks.



trails	Location of trails in, and near, Bellevue.
streetscapes	Polygon areas representing medians, parking strips and other areas managed by the City of Bellevue or others maintain, the cover type such as a planting bed, tree well or hard surface are tracked as well.
maincoverclass	Generalized cover classes within parks areas such as Forest Cover, Hard Surface, Open Water, etc.
citytrees	Street trees owned by the City and maintained by the Parks department.

fstation	Locations and designating numbers for the fire stations of the City of Bellevue Fire Department.
pstation	Locations and names of the substations of the City of Bellevue Police Department.

Topography (topo)

contour2ft	The location and elevation of the topographic contours (using a 2-foot contour interval) for Beaux Arts, Bellevue, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina, Yarrow Point, southern Kirkland, southern Redmond, northern Newcastle, northern Renton, western Issaquah and nearby unincorporated areas of King County.
contur10ft	The location and elevation of the topographic contours (using a 10-foot contour interval) for Beaux Arts, Bellevue, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina, Yarrow Point, southern Kirkland, southern Redmond, northern Newcastle, northern Renton, western Issaquah and nearby unincorporated areas of King County.



contur50ft The location and elevation of the topographic contours (using a 50-foot contour interval) for Beaux Arts, Bellevue, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina, Yarrow Point, southern Kirkland, southern Redmond, northern Newcastle, northern Renton, western Issaquah and nearby unincorporated areas of King County.

Transportation (trans)

arterial Location of arterial streets in Bellevue, as designated in Bellevue's Comprehensive Plan.

highway Location of freeways in and near Bellevue.

impactfee Locations and identification numbers for the City of Bellevue's transportation impact fee zones. These zones are based on trip patterns and land use distribution within Bellevue. It is assumed that each new trip generated by a new land use will impact the transportation network. Therefore, businesses within each zone are assessed fees that help mitigate these impacts.

pstreet Locations of private right-of-way in Bellevue area.

railroad Location of railroad tracks in and near Bellevue.

COBROW Location of public right-of-way in Bellevue area.

sidewalk Locations of and information about sidewalks in the Bellevue area.

snowroutes Locations of streets to be plowed in case of a snow event. Indicates order of priority for snow plow service.

strnet Locations and names of streets in and near Beaux Arts, Bellevue, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina, and Yarrow Point.



taz	Locations, and identifying numbers for, the Transportation Analysis Zones. These zones are used for collecting land use data. This data is then used to calculate trip origins and destinations. These trip calculation results then serve as basic data for much of the work done by the City of Bellevue's transportation modelers. These Transportation Analysis Zones are located in Beaux Arts, Bellevue, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina, Yarrow Point, southern Kirkland, southern Redmond, northern Renton, western Issaquah, and various nearby areas of unincorporated King County.
BikeNetwork	The delineation of existing and proposed bicycle facilities and intervening connections that form a complete network.
EVARoute	Defined evacuation routes over roads to be used during an emergency scenario during AM/PM.
Pednetwork	The delineation of existing and proposed pedestrian facilities (this includes sidewalks and trails) and intervening connections that form a complete network
realprop	Property owned by the City of Bellevue.

oilpipes	Oil pipeline owned by Olympic.
powerln	Electrical transmission line.
s-basin	Boundaries of the sewer basins.
sd-basin	Boundaries of the storm drainage basins and storm drainage areas in and near Bellevue.
sdisthist	Historical sewer districts.
wdisthist	Historical water districts.
ws_svcarea	Boundaries of the water and sewer service areas found in, or near, Bellevue.

****Google KML Files****

You need Google Earth in order to view these files. Google Earth is available free,
<http://earth.google.com/>

To view these "KML" or "KMZ" files, you must save them to your locally to your computer. Once downloaded you can navigate to file, for example "Bellevue_Zoning.kmz" and double click to open the file in Google Earth. You can also open the file in Google Earth by going to File --> Open and navigating to the "Bellevue_Zoning.kmz" for example. Once the file has loaded in Google Earth, each of the KML/KMZ files has a legend that can be viewed by expanding the layer on the left side of the program under "Places". Expand the "Legend" tree and you can click where you would like the legend to appear on the screen. If you expand the second item in the "Places" on the left side of the program you will see a list of all the attributes for the layer. For example if you have the Zoning layer open you will see a list of all the zoning types within Bellevue. It is not recommended to have more than one KMZ/KML open at one time as Google Earth begins to run slow. The parcel layer is very large and may run slow on some computers.
