**SUBJECT:** 2013-2024 Transportation Facilities Plan (TFP) Update Process:  
Status of Roadway-Intersection & Ped-Bike project evaluation

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## **Purpose**

At the Commission meeting on March 22, staff will report on the status of scoring and ranking candidate Roadway-Intersection projects and candidate Pedestrian-Bicycle projects. Staff will also share a summary of the results of the 2012 Budget survey, recently released by the Finance Department.

## **Background**

### Candidate Projects

Staff are currently evaluating and scoring the 49 candidate Roadway-Intersection projects according to the criteria endorsed by the Commission on January 9. Staff are also currently evaluating and scoring the 32 candidate Pedestrian-Bicycle project candidates, using (different) criteria endorsed by the Commission at the January 9 meeting. This evaluation is expected to be complete in time for the Commission meeting on April 12.

### Public Involvement

The City has recently released the report for the [2012 Budget Survey](#). At the March 22 meeting, staff will provide a summary overview of the results as they relate to Transportation issues. Commissioners are encouraged to review the report, posted on the Finance Department page of the City website (click on the Performance section of the page), in advance of the meeting.

The TFP survey and web map of projects remain active (until the end of this month); links are posted on the [Transportation Facilities Plan](#) webpage on the City website.

## **Next Steps**

As noted above, staff anticipate completing evaluation of the candidate Roadway-Intersection and Pedestrian-Bicycle projects in time for the April 12 meeting. At that meeting, staff will

present the results, together with public comments, staff recommendations and a proposed process for integrating the two lists of prioritized candidates into one consolidated list.

Staff will prepare a report on the public outreach elements (Open Houses, online survey, online project map) and input received. This will be transmitted to the Commission in conjunction with the April 12 meeting.
