We will collect the following items:

Note that 21 inch and under TV sets and monitors are collected curbside for free in Bellevue.

Television Sets

One TV 21 inches or under will be accepted at no charge. A \$20 cash-only fee will be charged for each TV over 21 inches. Television sets that are encased in wood, wood consoles, and big screen TVs, will be accepted for a \$25 cash-only fee. Projection TVs will be accepted for a \$30 cash-only fee.

Computer Monitors

You can bring one monitor 21 inches or less for free. A \$10 cash-only fee will be charged for each monitor over 21 inches. For each additional monitor there is a \$10 cash-only fee.

Electronic Equipment

Computer equipment and accessories, printers, copiers, fax machines and cellular telephone equipment. Equipment will be recycled or reused.

Secure Shredding of Confidential Materials

Shredding and recycling services for confidential papers and materials. Limit 5 file-sized boxes per participant.

Clean Scrap Lumber

Milled lumber, plywood, and pallets. These wood products must be untreated and unpainted. Please do NOT bring furniture, yard waste, stumps, branches, construction or demolition material – they will NOT be accepted.

Appliances & Scrap Metal

Auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), barbecues, metal lawn chairs, microwaves, stoves, iron, steel and other metals accepted. A \$25 cash-only fee will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer brought to the event. A \$5 cash-only fee will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating. No containers that previously or currently contain chemicals or paint will be accepted.

Auto Batteries

Car, truck, marine, and motorcycle lead acid type batteries only.

Household Batteries

Alkaline batteries: AAAA, AAA, AA, B, C, D cells. 6 volts or less only. Nickel-cadmium, mercury, lithium, silver, and small lead-acid (computer and telephone) batteries also accepted.

Porcelain Toilets & Sinks

Toilets will be accepted for a \$5 cash-only fee. Toilet seats, hardware and base wax rings must be removed.



Textiles and Reusable Household Goods

Clothing and miscellaneous household items in usable condition are accepted. Tax receipts available to donors. **NO items in need of repair, carpet, area rugs, mattresses, or furniture.**

Uncontaminated Petroleum Based Products/Antifreeze

We will no longer collect these materials.

Please call 425-452-6932 for a referral on where uncontaminated petroleum based products/antifreeze materials are accepted.

Propane Tanks

Residential tanks will be accepted for a \$5 cash-only fee.

Car, Light Truck & Motorcycle Tires

Radials, bias ply, steel belted and studded tires accepted. Limit 6 per load. No heavy truck or backhoe tires, no tires on rims.

Newspaper, Mixed Paper, Cardboard, Glass, Tin and Aluminum Cans

Please prepare these materials as you normally would for curbside collection.

Specific Plastics and Polycoated Paper

Please read the preparation requirements listed at the end of this section. Any items that do not comply with these requirements will not be accepted.



Plastic soda, liquor, peanut butter and mouthwash bottles made from PETE plastic. Only screw top bottles with a #1 recycling symbol will be accepted. No lids!



Plastic, milk, juice, and water jugs, liquid soap, shampoo, laundry detergent, lotion, and food bottles made from HDPE. Only screw top bottles with a #2 recycling symbol will be accepted. No margarine or yogurt tubs, bleach or one quart motor oil containers, or plastic bags. No lids!



Styrofoam "hot beverage" cups, fast food "clam-shell" containers, egg cartons, and meat trays; polystyrene clear rigid food containers such as cake domes and hinged salad containers. Look for a #6 on the bottom. **No Styrofoam packing materials such as "peanuts" or packing frames will be accepted!** Some local retailers will accept "peanuts." Please call 425-452-6932 for a referral.



Plastic plant containers. No clay or broken plastic containers will be accepted! Please note: some plant containers may be landfilled due to low market demand and/or contamination.



Plastic coated paper containers such as frozen food boxes, milk cartons, drink boxes, and round ice cream cartons.



Plastic Preparation Requirements

We send plastics to different companies, so please help us by doing the following:

1. Remove and discard ALL lids.
2. Rinse and FLATTEN all bottles and jugs.
3. Remove food or other contaminants from all plastics. All plastics must be clean and dry.



Do not bring: plastic lids, square ice cream cartons, plastic wrappers, microwave trays, cartons with food residue, or frozen juice containers with metal ends.

Why Should you Secure your Load?

Secure Your Load

For Safer Roads!

Vehicles arriving with unsecured loads at public or private transfer stations in King County can be charged an unsecured load fee.

Across North America, over 25,000 accidents are caused each year by litter that is either purposefully dumped by motorists or that falls out of vehicles with unsecured loads. Nearly 100 of those accidents are fatal. According to the Washington State Department of Transportation, road debris causes about 350 accidents every year on state highways. Even if you are going a short distance and not driving on a highway, you are still **required by law** to secure your load.



