Cost: Free for the general public and \$3 per person for Volkssport members.

Registration: 15K participants must register the morning of the event, between 8-10 am, at the Mercer Slough Blueberry Farm: 2380 Bellevue Way SE – pre-event registration is not available. 6K registration open until 12noon.

Shuttle Bus: Participants of the 15K walk will be shuttled from the Mercer Slough Blueberry Farm to the start of the Lake-to-Lake Trail at Weowna Park. Shuttle will run from 8-10 am.


