AGREEMENT AS TO STATUS AND OWNERSHIP
OF ASSETS, AND RESPONSIBILITIES AS
TO FIRE PROTECTION AND PAYMENT THEREFOR

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between the City of Bellevue, hereinafter referred to as "City" and King County Fire District No. 14, hereinafter referred to as "District", both being municipal corporations in King County, and with the intent to contract concerning their respective rights and obligations under the provisions of Section 24, Chapter 282, Laws of 1961, codified as RCW 35.13.250;

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS: 1. The District is presently furnishing fire protection services to the City on a contractual basis and under the contract for 1964 the City receives a credit for the 25% of its total payment to the District in 1964, or \$32,092.00, representing 1 mill of its assessed valuation.

2. The City is contemplating setting up its own fire protection department effective 1/1/65.

3. Several annexations to the City have been made since the execution of the contract for 1964 between the City and the District, resulting in the withdrawal of the annexed areas of Sherwood Forest, Woodridge and Norwood Village from the District.

4. These and future annexations affect ownership of District assets, and it is reasonable and necessary that an agreement be made between the parties specifying ownership of District assets, and a method of reimbursement to the City of the value of such assets as were involved in the aforesaid annexations, and a formula to be applied in the event of future annexations, together with setting the present amount due and payable as between the parties, and the method and terms of payment therefor;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed between the parties hereto as follows:

I

The District hereby credits the City with the sum of \$32,092.00 representing 1/4 of its 1964 payment to the District, such credit to be applied to any payment required to be made by the City for District assets.

II

District shall maintain ownership of all property presently used by the District, consisting specifically of Stations 1, 2, and 3, the real property thereunder, the equipment therein, and cash in the possession of King County. In the event

IV

That the annexation of the areas generally known as Woodridge and Norwood Village took place on August 11, 1964, and as of that date, the assessed value of real property in the District was \$35,784,593.00. That the assessed valuation of the annexed area real property was the sum of \$3,102,260.00.

V

That the District shall pay to the City, such sums as is represented by the percentage of value between the assessed valuation of real property within the District just prior to each annexation, for 1964, and future years, and the assessed valuation of real property within the annexed area, as against the agreed net valuation of the Fire District properties, including District funds on hand in the office of the County Treasurer, after inventory and appraisal by both parties, effective as of the date of annexation, less any existing credits owing to any municipal corporation, less any liabilities of the District, less any monies on hand for which the City has theretofore received credit, and less monies budgeted for working capital during the current year.

VI

That under the aforementioned formula, the District became indebted to the City as of April 9, 1964, for the Sherwood Forest annexation in the sum of \$17,361.74, representing 3.08% of the District's valuation, based upon an agreed net valuation as defined in Paragraph V. above as \$563,692.72.

VII

That under the aforementioned formula, the District became indebted to the City as of August 11, 1964, for the Woodridge, Norwood Village annexations in the sum of \$47,820.10, representing 8.66% of the District's valuation, based upon an agreed net valuation as defined in Paragraph V. above, as \$552,195.10.

VIII

That the 1964 contract between the parties was silent as to the portion of the Sherwood Forest annexation covered by City Ordinance 646 formerly within the District, and on which the District levied taxes. It thereupon became the responsibility of the City to furnish protection. A portion of the annexation was within Fire District #34 which levied taxes thereon, but the District is rendering service to the entire area subsequent to April 9, 1964. City therefore agrees to pay to the District the sum of \$1,513.00 representing 4 mills of assessed valuation of the real property (\$504,410.00) of the area formerly within Fire District #34, prorated over nine months of 1964, and no apportionment of costs of

X

That no interest will accrue on the various sums owing from either party hereto to the other, except on the balance of any sums due under the purchase of Station #1, and it is contemplated that any sums due from the District to the City shall be credited toward the purchase of Station No. 1, at such time as any future annexation shall require payment by the District to the City of sums in excess of those owed by the City to the District, such sums shall be credited against future purchases of assets by the City from the District.

XI

This contract shall go into effect on the 1 day of January, 1965.
