ORDINANCE NO. 3515

AN ORDINANCE creating a series of projects within the Utility Capital Improvement Program Fund No. 469; specifying the source or sources of funding therefor; and appropriating monies to said Fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Utility Capital Improvement Fund No. 469 the additional sum of \$2,759,000, from the following sources:

Water Utility Operating Fund No. 444	\$1,293,000
Utility Revenue Bond Fund No. 480	\$841,000
Contributions - City of Redmond	\$625,000
Total	<u>\$2,759,000</u>

Section 2. The following additional projects are hereby established within the Utility Capital Improvement Fund No. 469 and the amount appropriated to said Fund by Section 1, above, is allocated among said projects in the amounts set out opposite each project:
