CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3615

AN ORDINANCE authorizing acceptance of State funding and execution of an agreement with the State of Washington Urban Arterial Board; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues within Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 and authorizing expenditure of the funds for the construction of improvements to Main Street between Bellevue Way and 108th Avenue; C.I.P. No. PW-R-18.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to accept funding and execute that certain State of Washington Urban Arterial Board Accelerated Development Project Agreement for Construction Proposal, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 11073, in the amount of \$262,100 for the construction of improvements to Main Street between Bellevue Way and 108th Avenue; C.I.P. No. PW-R-18.

Section 2. All funds provided pursuant to the agreement with the Urban Arterial Board shall be deposited within Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 - Main Street - Bellevue Way to 108th Avenue Project, C.I.P. No. PW-R-18.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of the agreement.

Section 4. Upon execution and acceptance of the agreement, the budget for Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 shall be and hereby is amended by appropriating revenue received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues, as a result of the agreement herein authorized, to Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 in not more than the following amounts.

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
Main Street - Bellevue Way to 108th Avenue (C.I.P. Project No. PW-R-18)	\$262,100

Provided, however, that if the actual amount of revenue specified in the agreement should be less than the amount provided herein, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said lesser amount.

Section 5. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are authorized to expend UAB funds in the amount set forth in Section 4 herein for the Main Street - Bellevue Way to 108th Avenue project.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


