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CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3805

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City to apply to the Washington State Arts Commission for a grant to the Bellevue Repertory Theatre; and to enter into a grant award contract with the Commission therefor.

WHEREAS, the Bellevue Repertory Theatre desires to apply to the Washington State Arts Commission for a grant to fund a managing director position and to partially fund three performances of "Much Ado About Nothing" in September of 1987; and

WHEREAS, the funding guidelines of the Washington State Arts Commission partnership program require that an organization has been incorporated for one year prior to the date of a grant application; and

WHEREAS, the Bellevue Repertory Theatre does not meet this requirement, and the application therefore must be submitted by an umbrella organization on behalf of the Bellevue Repertory Theatre; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue qualifies as such an umbrella organization, and the Bellevue Arts Commission has recommended that the City act in such capacity in connection with the proposal of the Bellevue Repertory Theatre; and

WHEREAS, by acting in such capacity the City of Bellevue does not incur any financial liability to either the Washington State Arts Commission or the Bellevue Repertory Theatre; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the proposal of the Bellevue Repertory Theatre serves a public purpose and is in the public interest; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Bellevue is hereby authorized to act as an umbrella organization for the Bellevue Repertory Theatre in connection with its request to the Washington State Arts Commission for a grant to fund a managing director position for the period September 1, 1987 to June 30, 1988 and for a matching grant for three performances of "Much Ado About Nothing," to take place September 1 through 11, 1987.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary to make application to the Washington State Arts Commission for said grant, and to execute a grant award contract with said Commission.

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Section 3. There shall be established at the time of execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, a project within Grant Control No. 164, to be known as Bellevue Repertory Theatre Program Support and Staff Support, in which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for administration of said grant.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is: Washington State Arts Commission, \$2,000.00.

Section 6. Upon execution of acceptance of said grant award contract, the budget for Grant Control Fund No. 164 authorized by Ordinance No. 2475, as amended, is hereby amended by appropriating to that fund unanticipated revenues in excess of estimated revenue in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized to the Bellevue Repertory Theatre Program Support and Staff Support Program within Grant Control Fund No. 164, currently anticipated in the following amount:

Bellevue Repertory Theatre Program Support and Staff Support Program	\$2,000.00

Provided however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant award should be less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

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Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


