## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3887

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of a Client Services Contract with the Puget Sound Water Quality Authority (PSWQA) for the PSWQA to partially fund two model public involvement and education projects.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designated representative is authorized and directed to execute a Client Services Contract with the Puget Sound Water Quality Authority (PSWQA) to partially fund the Storm and Surface Water Utility's Stream Team Program and the Parks Department Mercer Slough Wetland Protection Program, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 13286

Section 2. The City Manager or his designated representative is authorized to receive monies and to expend same as authorized in said Contract.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said Contract.

Section 4. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the Client Services Contract is:

Section 5. Upon execution of said Client Services Contract, the budget for the Grant Control Fund shall be and hereby is amended by appropriating revenue received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues, as a result of the Client Services Contract herein authorized, to the Grant Control Fund in not more than the following amount:

Parks Department Mercer Slough Wetland Protection Project	\$10,000.00

Provided, however, that if the actual amount of revenue specified in said Client Services Contract should be less than the amount provided herein, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said lesser amount.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
