ORDINANCE NO. 3941

AN ORDINANCE relating to the parking of vehicles, and restricting the parking thereof on both sides of S.E. 1st Street between 140th Avenue S.E. and 136th Avenue S.E., in the City of Bellevue, Washington.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking of vehicles on the specified portions of the following street shall be restricted as follows:

S.E. 1st Street. Parking is prohibited eight a.m. to five p.m. on both sides of S.E. 1st Street between 140th Avenue S.E. and 136th Avenue S.E., except Saturday, Sunday and holidays.

Section 2. The parking restriction established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after final passage by the City Council.
