ORDINANCE NO. 4286

AN ORDINANCE authorizing application for and acceptance of state funding in the amount of \$243,600 for construction of Phase I of SE 8th Street and 118th Avenue SE (HOV Improvements), CIP Project No. PW-I-39; authorizing execution of an agreement with the State of Washington Transportation Improvement Board therefor; creating a new project within the Urban Arterial Trust Fund ; and amending the budget for Urban Arterial Trust Fund by appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to that fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to apply for and to accept state funding in the amount of \$243,600 for construction of Phase I of SE 8th Street and 118th Avenue SE (HOV Improvements), CIP Project No. PW-I-39; and to execute, on behalf of the City, an agreement with the State of Washington Transportation Improvement Board therefore, a copy of the agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 16965.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said agreement.

Section 3. There shall be established at the time of execution and acceptance of said grant award agreement, a project within the Urban Arterial Trust Fund, in which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

Section 6. Upon execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, the budget for the Urban Arterial Trust Fund is hereby amended by appropriating to that fund anticipated revenues in excess of estimated revenue in the amount of the grant proposal and acceptance herein

authorized to the Urban Arterial Trust Fund, currently anticipated in the following amount:

Urban Arterial Trust Fund - \$243,600
SE 8th Street and 118th Avenue SE
(HOV Improvements)

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said grant award should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




