ORDINANCE NO. 4438

AN ORDINANCE providing for parking restrictions on the west side of 134th Avenue N.E. from Bel-Red Road to N.E. 8th Street.

WHEREAS, 134th Avenue N.E. from Bel-Red Road to N.E. 8th Street is a collector arterial with unimproved shoulders on each side, the west side a walkway delineated with an eight-inch fog line; and

WHEREAS, one purpose of the walkway is to provide a safe route for pedestrians and bicyclists; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has received complaints of parking on the walkway; and

WHEREAS, a parking restriction will help to prevent vehicles from parking on the walkway, maintaining it for pedestrians and bicyclists; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Parking is prohibited on the west side of 134th Avenue N.E. from Bel-Red Road to N.E. 8th Street.

Section 2. The administration is hereby directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance with the Records Department of King County and to post appropriate signs indicating the parking prohibition.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


