CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4633

AN ORDINANCE regarding the Emergency Management Organization; amending Section 1 (part) of Ordinance No. 3384, Sections 2, 3, and 4 of Ordinance No. 4367; and Bellevue City Code 3.98.015, 3.98.020, and 3.98.040.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Sections 2 and 4 of Ordinance No. 4367, and Section 3.98.015 of the Bellevue City Code are amended to read as follows:

3.98.015 Operations

The organization shall operate under the policy guidance of the Bellevue Emergency Operations Plan which shall include the following operational elements: organization, responsibilities, concept of operations, administration and logistics, direction and control.

Section 2. Section 1 (part) of Ordinance No. 3384, as amended by Section 3 of Ordinance No. 4367; and Bellevue City Code 3.98.020, are amended to read as follows:

3.98.020 Director of Emergency Services

The organization shall be headed by the director of emergency services. The City Manager or his designee shall serve as the director of emergency services. The director shall be directly responsible for the organization, administration and operation of the emergency management organization. The Emergency Operations Plan and any amendments thereto shall be effective when approved by the director.

Section 3. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 4367; and Section 3.98.040 of the Bellevue City Code are amended to read as follows:

3.98.040 Emergency Operations Board

A. There is created and established an Emergency Operations Board to oversee and provide policy recommendations to the City Council during

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emergency and recovery periods, and to provide policy direction for development and maintenance of the Emergency Operations Plan. During any emergency or disaster, the Board shall also oversee and provide direction to the Emergency Management Committee, and shall be chaired by the Director of Emergency Services.

B. The Emergency Operations Board shall consist of the following members:

1. City Manager, who shall be the chairperson
2. Deputy City Manager, who shall be the vice-chairperson
3. City Attorney
4. Fire Chief
5. Police Chief
6. Director, Department of Community Development
7. Director, Department of Finance, Information, and Personnel Services
8. Director, Department of Parks and Community Services
9. Director, Office of Policy Planning
10. Director, Transportation Department
11. Director, Utilities Department
12. Director, Human Resources
13. Other departments or divisions as designated by Director

C. Each Department Director shall have specific duties and responsibilities for mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery as provided in the City of Bellevue Emergency Operations Plan and shall ensure that the policies established by the Emergency Management Organization in the Plan are implemented within their respective city departments.

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Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after passage by the Council.




