ORDINANCE NO. 4643

AN ORDINANCE changing the name of Lake Washington Boulevard SE between SE 50th Place and Hazelwood Lane to 106th Avenue SE.

WHEREAS, on February 2, 1993, the City annexed a portion of the Lake Heights/Newport Hills neighborhood from King County, acquiring a street with the designation "Lake Washington Boulevard SE"; and

WHEREAS, currently there are two "Lake Washington Boulevards SE" that run parallel to each other on both the east and west sides of I-405; and

WHEREAS, when responding to an emergency in this area, there could be some confusion as to which side of the freeway the emergency unit should be dispatched; and

WHEREAS, the prior designation does not conform to the official street designating ordinance; and

WHEREAS, public convenience and welfare will be served by a change in street name designation, now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Lake Washington Boulevard SE between SE 50th Place and Hazelwood Lane is hereby renamed to 106th Avenue SE.


