CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4849

AN ORDINANCE adopting an operating budget for the City of Bellevue, Washington, for the year 1996; and setting forth the estimated revenues and appropriations.

WHEREAS, a preliminary budget has been filed with the City Clerk as required by law; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the City Council upon notice as prescribed by law, at which time comments for or against any part of the budget were heard; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has made adjustments and changes as it deemed necessary or proper; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The budget of the City of Bellevue, Washington, for the year 1996, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 22383, is hereby adopted by this reference, in the aggregate total of estimated revenues and appropriations for all funds combined of \$143,728,162.

Section 2. The totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for each separate fund, as set forth herein, are:

General Fund	\$ 84,580,674
Development Services Fund	9,256,000
Parks Enterprise Fund	2,885,879
Sewer Utility Fund	22,360,687
Storm and Surface Water Utility Fund	8,859,475
Water Utility Fund	<u>15,785,447</u>
Total Operating Funds	\$143,728,162

Section 3. The job classifications and pay ranges for employees of the City, as set forth in the 1996 Compensation Plan, hereby adopted as part of the budget for 1996, and given Clerk's Receiving No. 22514, shall constitute the job classifications and pay ranges for such employees until changed by this Council.

Section 4. All employees who are members of a bargaining unit shall receive such pay and benefits as are provided for in the appropriate collective bargaining agreement.

Section 5. The provisions of Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4 of this ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1996.

Section 6. The Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Office of the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations and to the Association of Washington Cities.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.




